TODAY IN PACKERS HISTORY

The last five seasons that the Packers played on November 5th, they finished in first place in the division even though the overall November 5th record is 4-6. Some of the memorable games were:

- 1922: The Packers rolled to a 3-0 home field victory over the Columbus Panhandles before a crowd that was so large that its size could not be determined. (Like the Fridge.)
- 1961: Vince's first championship team stumbled 45-21 (fell on its face) at Baltimore before a crowd of 57,641 Colts fans.
- 1972: The division champion Packers outscored the San Francisco 49ers by a score of 34-24 at a sold-out County Stadium in Milwaukee.
- 1989: In the now famous "Instant Replay Game" the electronic eye overruled the field officials as the Majik-Man's Sharpe TD pass

gave the Heart Attack Pack a come-from-behind victory over the Bears at Lambeau.

1995: While Reggie White set foot on the Moon three times, Brett Favre connected for a touchdown pass to new Packer Keith Jackson. But it was kicker Chris Jacke who made the difference in the end by helping beat the Vikings under the dome 23-21.

PACKER PIECES

>>> Edgar Bennett's 589 rushing yards put him on pace for 1,179. The Packers haven't had a 1,000 yard rusher since Terdell Middleton (1,116) in 1978. With 170 carries, Bennett has just eight fewer than last season.

>>> With only six sacks in the last four games, the Pack might need to blitz more to put pressure on the quarterback.
