A win by the Packers at Tampa would all but clinch their first division title since 1972. For that to officially happen, Detroit also would have to lose at Houston. But even if the Lions win, their hopes of catching the Packers would be slim. They would trail by two games with two left, and the Packers currently hold the tiebreaker edge with a 22-point lead in net points in division games, the fifth tiebreaker.

ST. REGGIE

DE Reggie White who has been remarkably injury-free in his 11-year career, has suffered three significant injuries in a little more than a year. He pulled the hamstring in his left leg in the fourth quarter against Cincinnati and didn't practice this week, although he's hoping to play in Tampa Bay today. Reggie, who turns 34 later this month, sprained a medial collateral ligament in his left knee a month ago and played the next game. He tore ligaments in his left elbow a year ago and played four days later. Reggie has never missed a game in his career.

PACK PREPARE FOR BATTLE OF BAYS

The Packers practiced indoors in Green Bay this last week to get ready for today's game in Tampa Bay. Coach Mike Holmgren also turned up the heat to get the players ready for temperatures in the mid-70's instead of Green Bay's

recent freezing weather. "That's a real thing," Holmgren said of the temperature difference. "We'll do the same routine every time we go down there." Last season, the Packers beat the Bucs 34-19 with the temperature at 63 degrees. Green Bay leads the series with Tampa Bay (20-12-1) and has outscored the Bucs 646 to 501 over the past 19-years. The Pack has won the last six games against Tampa, and 10 of the last twelve meetings.
