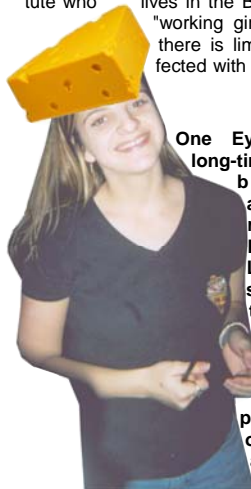


Letter From Up North

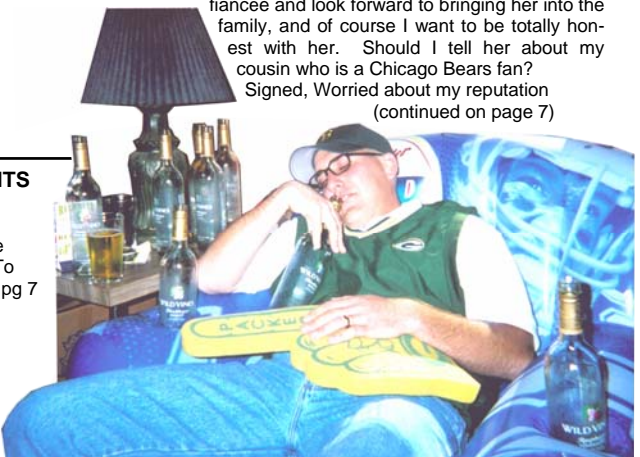

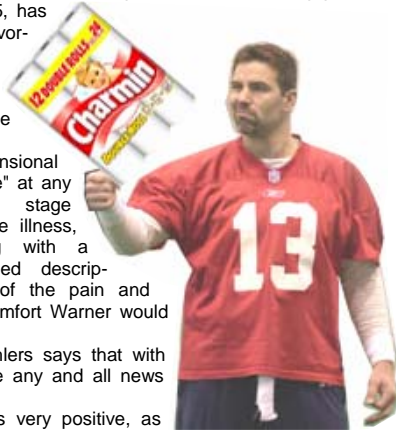

Today's game is being played in the newest of the leagues indoor facilities. It is just like going to a movie. Every seat is a big cushioned chair which you can push back to let people walk in front of you. The TWA Dome opened in 1996 after the Rams had played a season at Busch Stadium. I had the privilege of attending the 1996 World Champion Packers 24-9 win over the Rams in Green Bay's last game in St.Louis. The game was played

on a miserable Sunday evening. There was a terrible sleet storm. The temperature was just at freezing with very heavy precipitation and very heavy wind. To be blunt, had the game been outdoors, even the hardest veteran of the frozen tundra would have been tempted to be a "no show." That evening the Packers played a miserable first half trailing 9-3 while seemingly on their way to a third consecutive loss (They had lost at Kansas City and Dallas the two prior weeks). Very early in the second half, cornerback Doug Evans returned an interception for a touchdown turning the tide and the Packers went on to win.

Of the teams that Green Bay has played

at least 10 times, the Rams are one of three that hold a series lead over the Packers. The other two are Chicago and Dallas. The Rams who lead the series 43-39-2 won eleven straight from 1948 thru 1954.

Should the Packers win today all members are requested to remain after the game so we can layout the plans for next week. Hopefully Froggers will have their Super Bowl events as well.

No matter today's outcome it has been a great year for the club. Thank you each and everyone. Closing as I opened "It's Great Being Us".

Packers' Williams Injured in Domestic Violence Impressed Bears Sign Wife

Green Bay Packers cornerback Tyrone Williams received a cut on his arm in a domestic disturbance at his Green Bay home in which his wife was arrested.

Police say Williams' wife, Shantel, was arrested Tuesday night after the player was cut on the forearm, requiring several stitches. Shantel sat behind bars for several hours until Philadelphia Eagles' defensive coordinator Jim Johnson bailed her out of the Brown County Jail.

"We don't think the Packers will get past the Rams this Sunday, but we're not taking any chances," stated Johnson who put up the \$850 bond for Mrs. Williams Wednesday morning. "We need her kind of attitude on our defensive squad. If there's anyone who's really out to get the Packers right now, it's

Shantel. We've already signed her through the rest of the season. If the Packers beat St. Louis, we'll have her in a Eagles jersey by early next week."

If Green Bay beats heavily favored St. Louis, the Bears will host the Packers in the NFC Championship game. But what happens to Shantel if the Packers lose to the Rams? "She's on a one-way bus trip back to Green Bay," said Johnson.

Just minutes after Johnson escorted Shantel to a waiting Philadelphia Eagles staff vehicle, St. Louis head coach Mike Martz stormed into the County Jail shouting, "Where do I post bail?" ©
